VoC ASSESSOR REQUIREMENTS

To conduct a VoC, an Assessor must meet the following requirements:

Assessor Qualifications

A current Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (TAE), or the recognised assessor skill set from the Cert IV TAE.

Industry Skills

Industry skills, acquired over the past 5 years, current and directly relevant to the assessment being undertaken.

Collaborative Assessment

Where an assessor does not have all of the required competencies, one person, with all the training and assessment competencies, and one person, with more than 5 years' industry experience in the competency being assessed, may work together to conduct a collaborative assessment.

VET Knowledge

Current knowledge and skills in vocational education and training (VET) that informs their assessment.

Licenses

Vocational competencies at the level being delivered (hold a HRW licence to level they are assessing or above), (hold relevant essential licenses such as Working at Heights ticket).
